PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO) certification has been made mandatory since January 1, 2020 by the Malaysian Government. The new revised series of standards were launched in 2022, replacing the 2013 versions.

The MSPO certification scheme was developed with the purpose to ensure that the Malaysian palm oil industry can achieve the balance between the economic development, social development, and the protection of the environment through the implementation of the MSPO standards, i.e. the Malaysian Standard, MS 2530:2022 series.

This training will emphasise on the way forward for the MSPO certification as well as to provide information pertaining to the MS 2530:2022 series and its applicability.
